Congratulations on being selected for 'Group 1'.

Squad Statement

Group 1 is designed as a bridge between our LTS programme and Group 2. It offers swimmers 2 hours per week split across two sessions: one at Elswick on a Sunday and one at Dunston on a Friday evening. Swimmers in the group will be aiming to achieve GAW's selected elements of stages 7 and 8 of the Swim England Framework. Group 1 swimmers will compete in in-house development meets, our club championships and some swimmers may be selected to represent the club in the Northumberland and Durham Junior (Diddy) League.



Timetable

Day	Venue	Session Time
Friday PM	Dunston	19:30 - 20:30
Sunday PM	Elswick	15:00 - 16:00

Arrival

Swimmers should aim to arrive 10 minutes before each session and should be ready (capped up) to listen to instructions 5 minutes before the session start time. Swimmers should have all of their kit ready.

Coach

Group 1 is a bridging squad between Learn to Swim and the competitive side of the club, therefore swimmers will be introduced to all of our coaching team. Ken Nesworthy will oversee the group.

Attendance

Group 1 is usually for swimmers aged 7-10 (age at 31st December **2023**). To achieve best results in the pool, the expected attendance is set out below. Swimmers are expected to attend the competitions set out for this group.

Swimmers in Group 1 will compete in regular in-house development meets.

Attitude

In matters of swimming, swimmers will almost always be dealt with directly rather than through parents. Parents will receive communication where appropriate and necessary, to ensure messages are clear and consistent.

Failure to meet behaviour and attitude standards will lead to ejection from sessions. This is a last resort.

Swimmers should not use photography in the changing rooms.

Performance

There are no performance requirements/expectations for swimmers in Group 1. With the right attendance and attitude, a swimmer's performance will take care of itself in the long term.

Progression

All squad movement is at the discretion of the <u>head coach</u>. Please refer to the GAW Group Structure. Squad places are not permanent, they are to be earned through **attendance and attitude**.
